Remembrance Day, also known as Armistice **Day**, marks the **day** World War One ended, at 11am on the 11th **day** of the 11th month, in 1918. A minutes silence is held at 11am to **remember** the people who have died in wars.

- Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
Children who live in NSW.
