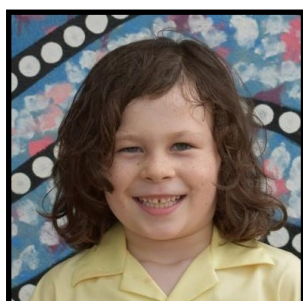

- Enrolments into **local** schools only
- Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.
Children who live in NSW.
